



# Shared Situational Awareness

In the initial stages, pass information between emergency responders and control rooms using the ME/THANE Framework

| M | Major Incident       | Has a major incident or standby been declared?<br>If 'NO' then complete ETHANE message  |
| E | Exact Location       | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Confirm nearest junction or exact address</li><li>▪ Confirm geographic size of the incident</li></ul>   |
| T | Type of Incident     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Explosion, building collapse, firearms incident etc.</li></ul>  |
| H | Hazards              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Identify the hazards ▪ Consider potential or secondary devices</li></ul>  |
| A | Access               | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Is evacuation necessary?</li><li>▪ Update with routes that are safe to use</li><li>▪ Clarify blocked routes</li><li>▪ Nominate and search the RVP</li></ul> |
| N | Number of Casualties | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ List type and severity</li><li>▪ Approximate number of dead, injured, survivors and witnesses</li></ul>   |
| E | Emergency Services   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ List present services and those required</li><li>▪ Conduct a joint dynamic hazard assessment</li></ul>  |
